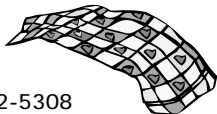


QUILTS

CLASS 11

Entry fee: 10% deducted from winners + GST

Entries will be accepted in Building #1 between 5pm and 9pm, Thursday September 13th only.

All committee members wear white cotton gloves.

RULES:

1. Judges may discard old or soiled exhibits.
2. Quilts may be shown maximum 2 years only.
3. All quilts must be no smaller than 72"x90" (1.83m x 2.29m) in sections 1 to 9.
4. Quilts must be hand quilted unless otherwise stated.
5. No long arm machine quilting.

ONTARIO ASSOCIATION OF AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES HAND QUILT COMPETITION

1. Quilt to be double size, at least 72"x90" (1.83m x 2.29m). Champion and Reserve Champion Quilt will be chosen from prize winners in Section 1-6.
2. Champion Quilt to compete at the District 6, Annual Meeting on November 10th, 2007.
3. If a quilt wins Grand Champion at more than one fair, the exhibitor must send the quilt on behalf of their home fair or the fair nearest his/her home address. The other fair then must send the Reserve Champion quilt.

Prizes: ① \$25, ② \$15, ③ \$10

4. The 1st prize quilt from the District is entered in the competition at the O.A.A.S. convention in Toronto in February 2008. The exhibitor of the Grand Champion Quilt will receive a \$500 cash prize from the O.A.A.S. and retain their quilt.
5. If an exhibitor does not wish their quilt to compete in this competition, please include this information on your entry form. The Reserve Champion Quilt is eligible to compete in the place of the Grand Champion Quilt.
6. The quilt design and pattern designer must be named, if applicable.

ONTARIO ASSOCIATION OF AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES MACHINE QUILT COMPETITION

1. Quilt to be minimum double size, at least 72"x90" (1.83m x 2.29m). Entries chosen from Sections 8 & 9 must be made and quilted by exhibitor, no long arm machines.
2. Grand Champion or Reserve Champion Quilt will be eligible to compete at District 6 Convention on November 10th, 2007.

Prizes: ① \$25, ② \$15, ③ \$10

3. The 1st prize quilt from the District will be entered in the competition at the O.A.A.S. convention in Toronto in February 2008. The winner of the Grand Champion Machine Quilt will receive a prize from the O.A.A.S. and retain their quilt.

4. The Reserve Champion Machine Quilt is eligible to compete in place of the Grand Champion Machine Quilt.
5. If an exhibitor wins Grand Champion at a fair other than their own fair, or at more than one fair, the exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest their home address as the one from which the quilt will be sent to the District Meeting.
6. The quilt design and pattern designer must be named, if applicable.

1. Quilt, pieced
2. Quilt, hand appliquéd
3. Quilt, plain on both sides, fancy quilting
4. Quilt, cheater
5. Quilt, exhibitor's choice
6. Quilt, pieced and quilted by a group or organization
7. **SPECIAL:** The Grace Mitchell Memorial Trophy sponsored by the Lorne Mitchell Family. A Trophy and \$75 will be presented to the Grand Champion Quilter.
- 7a. **SPECIAL:** Reserve Champion Quilter - \$20 sponsored by Heather Murphy.

8. Quilt - pieced - machine quilted
9. Quilt - sampler - machine quilted
10. Quilt, any size, machine quilted
11. **SPECIAL:** Champion Machine quilted quilt - \$50 Gift Certificate, sponsored by the Quilters Dream, 252 Dundas Street East, Waterdown

12. Quilt, single, pieced - hand quilted
13. Child's quilt - nursery design, no purchased panel – hand quilted
14. Child's quilt - hand appliquéd - hand quilted
15. Child's quilt - made from a purchased panel – machine quilted
16. Child's quilt - pieced - machine quilted
17. Quilt, single or double - using odds and ends – machine quilted
18. Jacket or vest, pieced or appliquéd, machine quilted if required

19. Pillow - appliquéd and hand quilted
20. Pillow - pieced and hand quilted
21. Quilt block, pieced
22. Quilt block, appliquéd

23. Article of quilting made by 3 years or less experience.

24. Wall Hanging - Machine quilted - Maximum size: 180" perimeter. **Prizes:** ❶ \$20 gift certificate, ❷ \$15 gift certificate, ❸ \$10 gift certificate, sponsored by Country Quilters Guild.

25. Wall hanging - Hand Quilted - Maximum size: 180" perimeter. **Prizes:** ❶ \$20 gift certificate, ❷ \$15 gift certificate, ❸ \$10 gift certificate, sponsored by Country Quilters Guild.
26. Grace Mitchell Memorial Award - Four quilted place mats, representing our Theme, "Apples and Spice and All Things Nice". **Prizes:** ❶ \$15, ❷ \$10, ❸ \$5, sponsored by the Woodburn Women's Institute.
27. Memory quilt or Family Tree quilt. **Prizes:** ❶ \$20, ❷ \$10, ❸ \$8, sponsored by Mae Burrows.
28. Quilt top (cotton) pieced. **Prizes:** ❶ \$20, ❷ \$10, ❸ \$8, sponsored by Crandun Technologies.
29. Scrappy Quilt - Minimum 72"x90" (1.83m x 2.29m) - hand quilted. **Prizes:** ❶ \$25 Gift Certificate, sponsored by the Quilt Rack, 356 Wilson Street East, Ancaster, ❷ \$12, ❸ \$10 sponsored by the BAS
30. Judges Award - excluding Grand Prize winners - \$10, sponsored by the BAS.
31. Exhibitor winning the most points in Sections 1-29 will receive \$10, sponsored by the BAS.
