The winner of this class is invited to enter the 60% whole wheat bread competition at the District 6 Annual Meeting, Saturday November 1st, 2008. The winner of this has the opportunity to enter the Ontario competition at the O.A.A.S. convention in February 2009. Prizes will be awarded at each level of the competition.
